May is the month of Mary. For centuries, the Catholic Church has set aside the entire month to honour Mary, Mother of God.

Fr Joe's Reflection - Sixth Sunday of Easter Year B God is love?

We don't love God like we love a good meal. The Ancient Greek-speaking world talked about love in many ways.

Philia describes the mutual affection and obligations towards each other of close friends or brothers. A similar word in meaning was *storge which* described the bonds of affection and duty owed between members of a family.

Wild romantic love was called *eros*. The Greeks viewed *eros* as a form of madness. It described the desire or need for another beyond rational thought.

Xenia, or hospitality, was the care and friendship you showed to strangers and travellers. It demanded mutual respect between guest and host. It was given with a hope that if the positions were reversed that you would be treated the same.

The word translated as love in today's *Gospel* and the *First Letter from John* is *agape*. This is the desire for the good of another without any expectation of reward. It is a love that demands no obligations in return. It is a self-sacrificial and self-less love.

God is Agape. God gives without any need for reward. God's love is self-less. God does not love us because we are fault-less or sin-

less. God's love doesn't have favourites. God loves everyone. In a particular Franciscan vision of salvation Jesus didn't come because we had sinned. Jesus came to show God's love. It is through Jesus' love that we are forgiven and invited into God's kingdom.

Jesus also wants us also to love him as a friend. He wants us to get to know him. He wants us to be bound in friendship. He wants us to have mutual obligations of care for each other. It is love as *philia*. Jesus does not command as one would to a servant or slave. He however points out the obligations and demands of being in friendship with him. His friends are to love self-lessly, to love as *agape*, to love like God, thinking only about the good of the other.

God's love is universal. God selflessly wants the best for everyone and everything. He loves the saint and sinner, the agnostic, the atheist, and all of humanity.

God's love is also personal. To be called a Christian is to be a friend of Jesus. Friendship comes with obligations. That obligation is to love God and each other, selflessly like God. That is the sign of being a Christian.

This is my commandment: love one another, as I have loved you.


